

BUSHWACKER'S P.H.

WALSALL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1988
12 BRADFORD STREET ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION 1994

WHEREAS

(1) the Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") is the Local planning authority for the purposes of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

(2) the Council is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the schedule hereto should not be carried out to the property known as 12 Bradford Street, Walsall, which was formerly the Tavern in the Town Public House and which is now The Bushwackers Public House, shown on the plan annexed hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning Development Order 1988.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development of the said property of the description set out in the Schedule hereto, being development within Class C of Part 2 of Schedule 2 to the above Order and not being the development comprised within any other class.

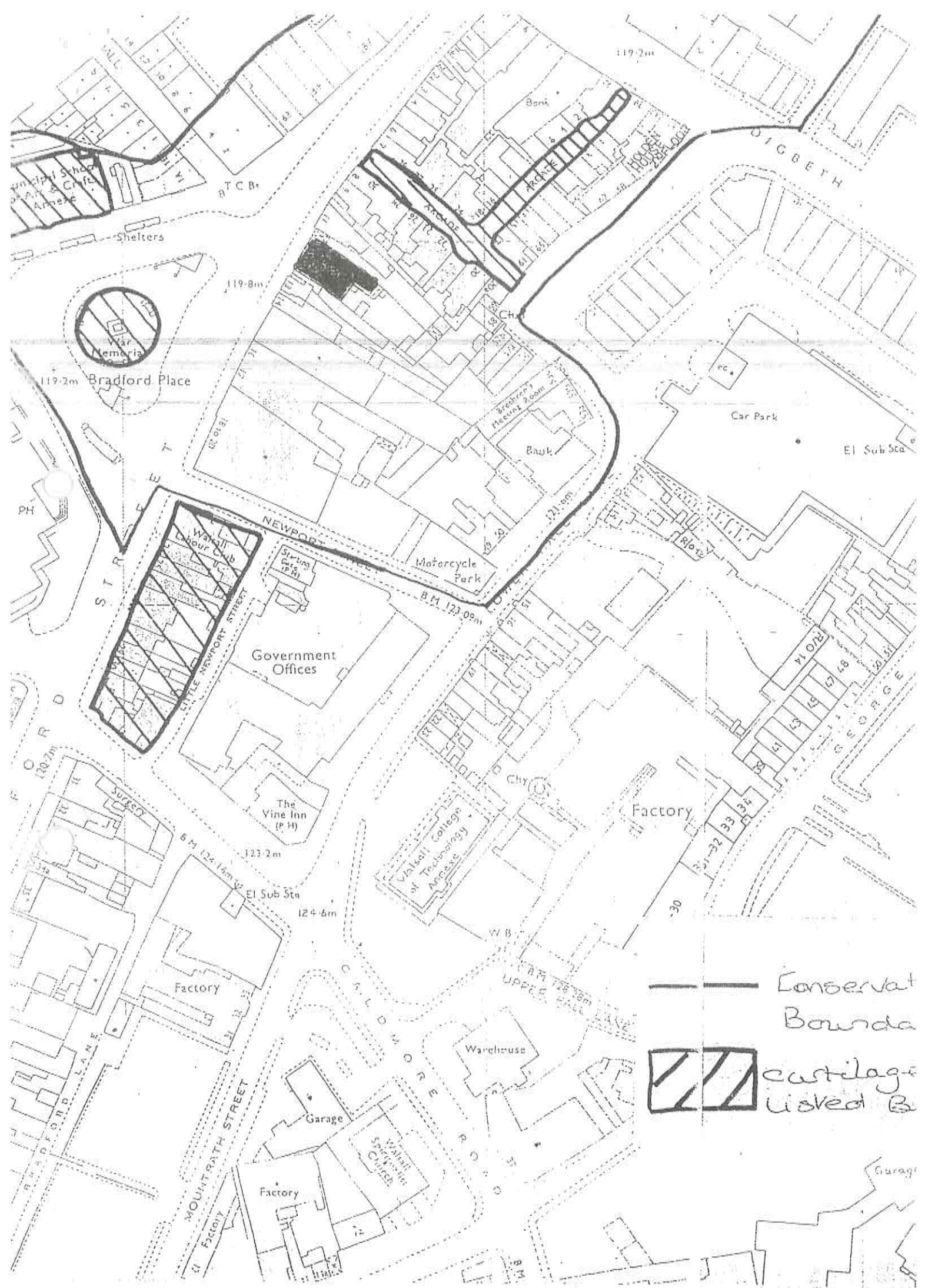
