WALSALL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1977 NOS. 52-88 (EVEN NOS.) MOAT ROAD, WALSALL

WHEREAS the Walsall Metropolitan Borough Council being the Local Planning Authority for the Metropolitan Borough of Walsall are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land edged red on the plan annexed hereto, being the dwellinghouses nos. 52-88 (even nos.) Moat Road, Walsall, and the land occupied therewith unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977 and WHEREAS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said description would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 should apply to this Direction.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.

This Direction is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until the 1st day of October , 1979 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

SCHEDULE

The construction within the curtilage of any of the said dwellinghouses of a hardstanding for vehicles for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouses as such being development comprised within Class I referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.
